- Double (and Triple) Check for Errors Check the spelling, proofread and edit for grammar and typing errors. Have someone else read through your form to check for these errors as well.
 Any errors make the selection committee think you didn't put your best effort into the process.
 Make them see how important this is to you!
- Be Accurate Explain all acronyms and organizations. For example, others may not know what FCCLA is or stands for. Explain more than just a name, help them understand.
- Don't Exaggerate As tempting as it is to stretch the truth, most evaluators can see through these tactics. It is best to be the real you and highlight your talents, interests, and achievements. Dishonesty may cause you to loose credibility and undermine the amazing truthful things you have included on the form.

Instructions

Please use the following instructions / tips to assist you in filling out each section of the form.

Leadership:

<u>Organizations/Work Experience</u> – List the title of the organization or affiliation. Possible areas include school, community, church, work, civic, camps. Examples include: FCCLA, Athletics, Peer Counseling, Teacher's Aide, Power Drive, 4-H, Girl/Boy Scouting, Church Youth Activities, Youth Leadership Tomorrow, Student Council, Work Experience,

<u>Description</u> - Please describe the activity or organization in detail as to your involvement (list what you do in each area). This may be in list or narrative form. Although participation is a form of building leadership skills, make sure to highlight times in which you took on more of a leading role or have demonstrated initiative above the norm.

<u>Leadership Positions</u> - List any elected, appointed, or self-initiated level of leadership you provide in this area. Examples include: Offices held (President, Secretary, etc), Team Captain, Shift Manager, Organized summer activities for team, Group Leader, Camp Counselor, etc.

Remember: These can be given 'titles' or assumed roles you have had.

<u>Years:</u> Mark in which grades each activity took place. Remember that only activities from grades 9-12 should be listed.

Examples include FCCLA Service projects (Bloodmobile, Honey Sunday, etc.) MAP Service Learning Projects, road clean up projects, church service projects, working with young children or the elderly, assisting peers, special assistance to school, etc. Remember to list as many service opportunities as you can and be thorough in your description of the activity and your involvement.

Organization – List what group you participated in this activity with (if applicable).
